She attends the piano course at the Puccini Music Institute in Gallarate (VA) with Massimo Neri, graduating with full marks and honours. In the same Institute she obtained the Specialistic Diploma of Second level in Musical Doctrines, graduating with full marks.

At the University of Milan she gets the degree in philosophy with full marks and honours, discussing a dissertation about the pianistic didactics.

She gets many awards at National and International piano competitions. Among them she wins 19 First Prizes at the competitions held in Casale Monferrato (C. Soliva), Cortemilia, Bobbio, Milano (C. Vidusso), Albenga, Cesenatico, Grosseto, Sestri Levante, Pescara, Vasto, Piombino, Gioia del Colle, Tradate, Gioia del Colle).

She gets the Second Prize - with First not awarded - other six times and worth mentioning, the Second Prize at the M. Clementi National Competition of Florence.

She comes third at the XXI "Premio Rendano" National Piano Competition of Cosenza (South of Italy), and second at the V° "C. Fineschi" National Piano Competition (Rome).

She attends a postgraduate course as permanent member with Emilia Fadini, Lazar Berman and François-René Duchable and she works with Musical Associations as soloist and as collaborator pianist (International Courses of High Specialization with teachers of "Santa Cecilia National Academy" in Rome and International Summer Courses of the Association "Amici della Musica F. Fenaroli" in Lanciano).

She follows a postgraduate course with Marcella Crudeli at the Ecole Normale de Musique de Paris, where she obtains the Brévet d'Exécution, with unanimous approval, the Diplôme d'Exécution and the Diplôme Supérieur d'Exécution.

She embarked very young upon an active artistic career both as a soloist and a chamber musician, always enthusiastically. An equal success she had with her latest Compact Discs, with musics of Schumann, Rachmaninoff, Scarlatti, Haydn, Chopin, Cimarosa.

She is Art Director of the "Più che suono" Musical Association.
